To Whom It May Concern:

Please understand that you are filing an application for a permit to excavate. This application must be approved before any work begins.

The only exception to this would be in the event of an emergency, such as a water main break.

NOTE:

All street cut permits must be submitted for processing forty-eight (48) hours in advance of date you wish to begin excavation.

The applicant must have a copy of the street cut permit signed by the Street Commissioner and the Town Engineer before any excavation is made.

APPLICATION FEE: Fifty dollars (\$50.00) per opening, cut, or boring to be submitted to the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Chesterton at time of application to cover the cost of inspection and processing of application for a street cut & thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for a sidewalk cut. I hereby agree to perform all work in a street, alley, or public grounds of the Town of Chesterton in accordance with the latest revision of standard details and/or ordinance of said Town.

All excavations under pavement shall be backfilled with Flowable Fill meeting the INDOT Standard Specifications. The specific mix design must be approved by the Street Commissioner and the Town Engineer.

In certain instances, the Flowable Fill requirement may be waived by the Street Commissioner and the Town Engineer. In these instances, all excavations under pavement shall be backfilled with Compacted Aggregate Limestone Base INDOT No. 53 or INDOT No. 8 stone to the base of the pavement. All work shall be in accordance with INDOT Standard Specification Section 211 and its latest revisions.

I further agree that all surfaces, piping, and/or structures removed, disturbed, or otherwise altered by the work shall, at applicant's expense, be returned to its original condition or to a condition meeting the existing requirements of the Town of Chesterton, whichever is more stringent.

I further agree to provide bond and liability insurance as required in Ordinance 81-09.
