### ACTIVITY REPORTS

Chief Cincoski provided the Commission with the 2014 year end review and annual report.

### OLD BUSINESS

Chief Cincoski advised that background investigations have been completed on the top 10 candidates for the patrol hiring process and hiring list. Chief Cincoski advised that Voice Stress Analysis (V.S.A.) tests will be completed on the 10 candidates on March 4, 2015. Chief Cincoski requested the Commission schedule an executive session for the purpose of interviewing the prospective candidates. Mike Orlich moved and the Commission approved to schedule the executive session for Wednesday, March 4, 2015 in the Police Department conference room. Chief Cincoski will ensure that the proper public notice is distributed.

Chief Cincoski reported that Canine Igor is still recovering and is expected for at least a partial return to duty. Igor will begin physical therapy soon and hopefully have the rod removed from his leg shortly.

Chief Cincoski reported that the investigation into the fleet vehicle order for 2015 has been placed on hold pending the future receipt of funds into the Town CCD Fund.

Chief Cincoski reported that a department wide staff meeting was held on February 6, 2015. Staff members were advised of ongoing projects and initiatives. Several staff members were recognized for department longevity and department awards.

Chief Cincoski requested that Part-time Communications Clerk Lori Maddox and Nina Serrano be promoted from PT CC II to I. Upon a motion by Mike Orlich and approval of the Commission the promotions were made effective.

The Commissioners was advised of the CEDIT request to the Town Council of funding approved for the funding of 800 mghz portable radios. The need , reasons and plan for the program implementation were also provided.

Chief Cincoski provided the Commission with information regarding professional law enforcement accreditation and asked the Commission to review the information for discussion at a future Commission meeting.

The Commission was provided with an amended Chapter 1 of the department Rules and Regulations for the Commission's approval, primarily relating to position and job descriptions. With a motion from Brandon Kroft and approval of the Commission, approval was tabled.
