### REPORTS

**MS 4 PROGRAM REPORT** – No Report.

**SUPERINTENDENT REPORT** – Town Engineer Mark O’Dell said MS4 Coordinator, Jennifer Gadzala, started reviewing a new MS4 NPDES permit. Coordinator Gadzala said they are still waiting on comments from the EPA and would have to address those comments, putting this permit action towards the beginning of the new year. However, a construction permit may be released before the end of the year. Also, Springdale will be undergoing paving. Engineer O’Dell said they will start working on the budget after the October meeting and provide that information when it is available.

**OTHER REPORTS** –Street Commissioner John Schnadenberg said they had a culvert failure at Westchester and 15<sup>th</sup> and had to replace 60ft. of culvert under Westchester. All work was done in house. Commissioner Schnadenberg said they have also been working on their work orders for storm drains, in which they hydro excavate the pipes and fill in with material. Commissioner Schnadenberg said he would provide some photos of samples of these types of repairs for review at the next meeting. There are quite a few work orders for this type of issue. Engineer O’Dell mentioned they had used the mini excavator that was rented to scrape any excess branches and litter to keep the Peterson ditch as open as possible.

OLD BUSINESS

**CR 1050 Ditch**—Town Engineer Mark O’Dell reported that he and Street Commissioner John Schnadenberg met with DLZ for a scoping meeting on the CR 1050 ditch. DLZ would be doing the survey work. They are working with DLZ on a daily rate for surveying all the different elevations. Design for the project will be done in house and the project will be started in the spring.

**23<sup>rd</sup> Street Storm Sewer**—Town Engineer Mark O’Dell and Street Commissioner J. Schnadenberg said that they have been using the new nozzles to clean out the storm sewers.
